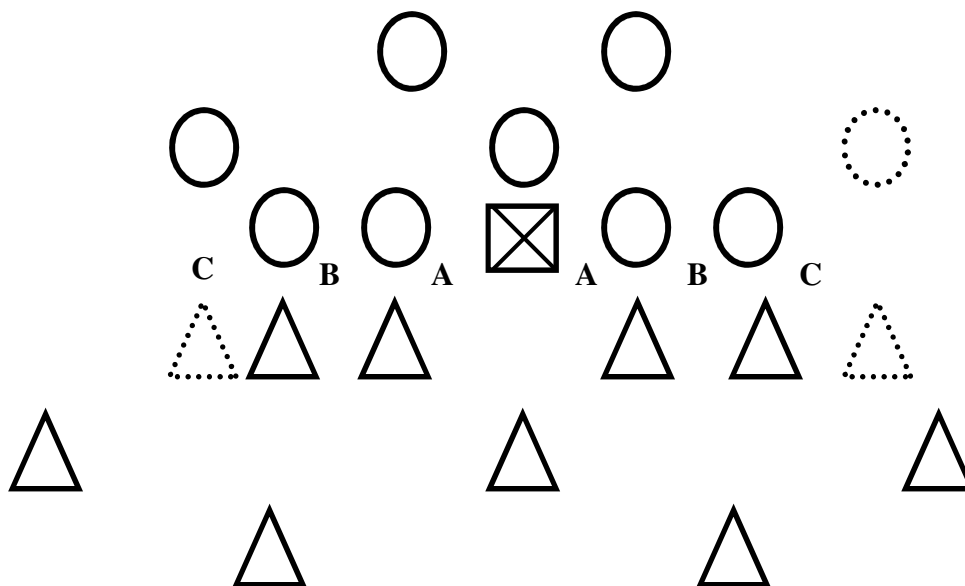


EXHIBIT II to GENERAL RULES OF G19YFL

4-3-2 DEFENSE for 6/7 Year Olds



Offensive Line

- The Maximum split for all Offensive Line positions will be fingertips to fingertips.
- Offensive Linemen are permitted to pull at all ages.
- You are only permitted to line up 5 players on the offensive line. The line must be balanced with two players on either side of the center.
- Your RB's can line up in the wing position or spread as WR but can not be on the LOS and trips are illegal.

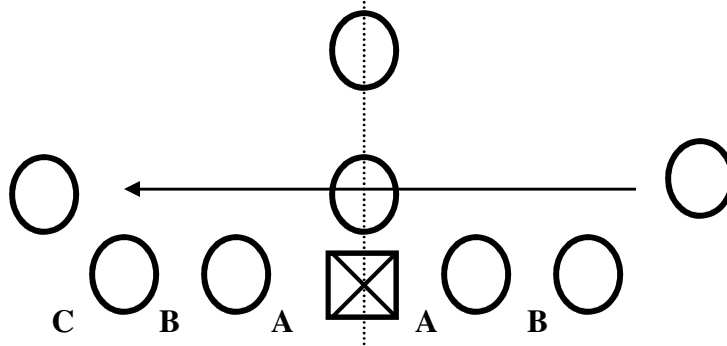
Defensive Line

- Defensive Guards must line head-up with their Offensive Line counterpart and hit head-up.
- Defensive Tackles must line up head-up on the Offensive End unless a wing is utilized in which case the Defensive Tackle can line up head-up on the wing on in the gap between the offensive tackle and the wing.
- Defensive Linemen are NOT permitted to shoot the "A" gap. Can't make contact with center until player establishes himself as a blocker.
- Defensive Ends are permitted to shoot the "B" and "C" gap - Ends are permitted to loop and/or stunt but can not loop into the "A" gap. While Offensive and Defensive Ends must line heads up, they do not have to hit heads up. Offensive Linemen are permitted to pull and Defensive linemen, as defined above can loop and shoot the "B" & "C" gaps.

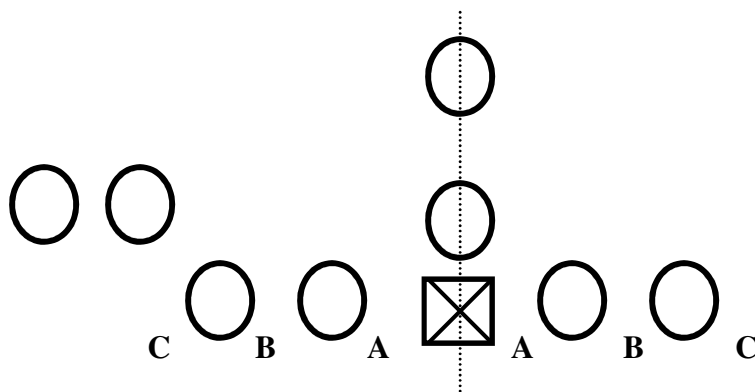
Defensive Backfield

- All Linebackers must be 2 yards from the line of scrimmage.
- Outside Linebackers must be 2 yards from the line of scrimmage and a minimum of 1 yard off the outside shoulder of the Defensive End. There is no maximum to the outside, an Outside Linebacker can spread as wide as desired.
- Defensive Backs may play inside or outside the outside linebacker, but they must be 6 yards off the line of scrimmage. Unless a receiver is deployed at which time the DB must be 2 yards from the LOS.
- LB's and DB's are NOT permitted to cross the line of scrimmage until either the ball is handed off to a RB or WR or the QB carries the ball outside the tackles.
- BLITZING IS NOT PERMITTED!!!

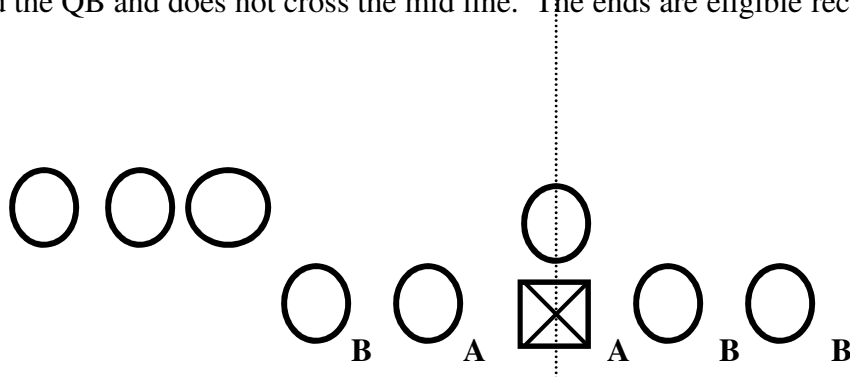
6/7 Offensive Formations



The above formation has a wing on the left and a wing on the right and a wing in motion. This is a **legal formation** as long as the running back in the back field is lined up behind the QB and does not cross the mid line.



The above formation is a **legal formation** provided the running back in the back field is lined up behind the QB and does not cross the mid line. The ends are eligible receivers.



The above formation is considered trips and is an illegal formation because the running back is beyond mid line.
