**Meeting called to order** at 8:10 PM.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes:** Motion to approve PT and 2<sup>nd</sup> by KOA and minutes were approved.

**Treasurer Report:** Current Balance \$436.04. Check for \$80 written to cover grove permit for the coaches smoker.

**Old Business:**

1. Bret Harsh – putting bid together for EMT/medical service for the G-19 league. He will attend the next meeting and wants to discuss universal pricing to provide service to G19. League will discuss after the presentation and decide how to proceed.
2. Rick Young from Peters is invited to April meeting to discuss concussions to the league. We will also look at having a 15 minute presentation at the smoker to all coaches on basic symptoms for concussions.
3. League will look into getting the IMPACT test or access to it for all of G19 to use. Cost is in the \$800 to \$1000 range.
4. NA will be looking at new scale guy for smoker. NA and SV have used them in the past and they were very good.
5. South Suburban 12/13 update – no new information at this point. NA has 14 signed up so far and are aggressively looking for 5 to 10 more kids, PT will have at least 1 team at 12. KOA is trying hard to get 12s teams. South Suburban updates – West Allegheny would

like to bring their 12s team to G19 because they had issues with player safety and helath in the SSYFL Last year. Long-term may make G19 a 12s only league and 12/13 teams could go to SSYFL.
