**New Business:**

1. Jim Render – USC Football – Summer Camp opportunities – June 5<sup>th</sup> – Two sessions – morning 9a to 12p at USC High School OR 2:30p to 5:30p at Southpointe Fieldhouse. 2. Dr. Nate Kegel – UPMC Sports Medicine and also concussion and IMPACT program expert. Test is 20 minutes of focused attention.
  - a. Age range – 10 to 16; pediatric version can start at around age 5 but that version is not perfected.
  - b. [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov) – search for concussion and there is a lot of material on signs and symptoms of concussions.
  - c. [www.impacttest.com](http://www.impacttest.com) is the site for the IMPACT test. You can get your baseline done at the southside facility. It is about \$20 per person and the baseline is saved in the event it is needed at a future date. You would go back to UPMC for follow-up and future testing. Phone number is: 877-646-7791.
  - d. Three things to look for (but take to doctor if there is any question):
    - i. Confusion, delayed response to questions.
    - ii. Eye tracking – non-fluid movement of eyes when tracking your finger back and forth or up and down.
    - iii. Give three words to remember, wait a few minutes and ask them what the three words were.
  - e. Build a concussion awareness section on the web site to provide pointers to the information that is available.
